Requirements for appointment

Further to the above qualifications, all applicants should:

- Be unemployed Kenya graduates from recognized training institutions who have completed their degree courses and have not been exposed to work experience related to their area of study;
- Be graduates of degree programmes, for whom internship is a requirement for registration by their respective professional bodies;
- Not have retired or exited from formal employment; and
- Not have benefited from a similar programme.

- Internship shall be non-remunerative. However, interns will be paid a stipend as may be determined by the public service Commission (PSC) from time to time.
- Duration for internship for all the vacancies advertised herein is three (3) months.
